ASP SPORTS PROGRAM

ASP offers its students a comprehensive range of extra-curricular sporting experiences within the framework of an interscholastic program.

The year is divided into three seasons with the following sports offered at the Varsity, Junior Varsity, Middle School and Lower School levels.

Students in grades 8-12 are eligible to try-out for the Varsity teams (when cuts have to be made and student's abilities are equally matched Upper School students will have preference over 8th grade students), those in grades 8-11 for the Junior Varsity teams (in Cross Country, Swimming and Track & Field 7th graders are also eligible). Those in grades 6-8 are eligible for the Middle School teams. All Lower School grades are eligible for the intramural program.

Varsity teams practice from 3:40 pm to 6:00 pm on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday.

Junior Varsity teams practice in the same time slot on Tuesday and Thursday.

Middle School teams usually practice on Tuesdays and Wednesdays but days and times can vary per season.

Lower School teams practice on Saturdays and grades 3-5 can also participate on Fridays with a required pick up at 17:00 from ASP!

Sign-up sheets will be posted on the website and e-mailed for Middle School and Lower School sports.

Those students chosen to represent the school at the Varsity level (and at JV level in Cross Country, Swimming and Track & Field) will participate in the International School Sports Tournament (ISST) at the end of each season.

This tournament, founded 41 years ago, is attended by 12 of the largest American/ International schools in Europe and is hosted in a different city each year. For the 2010/11 school year the tournament venues are as follows:
