	<p><b>PFA LOUNGE/VIDEO VAULT</b> The best place to learn about the school, find out about local activities, rent English Language movies, buy English language books, browse ASP logo wear, hang out &amp; get to know your fellow ASP families. Volunteer in this room for two or four hour shifts throughout the year.</p>
	<p><b>FRIENDS OF THE ARTS</b> support the drama, fine art and music departments by assisting with events and programs. They raise funds to help support: post concert receptions, drama and musical productions, student art exhibits, IB film festival, MS Honor Band Festival, replace musical equipment and sponsor the "Diane Flaum/Bev Price Arts Scholarship."</p>
	<p><b>FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY</b> support the Lower and Middle School library and the Upper School library. They provide a program called "Birthday Books", where parents can buy a book and donate it to the Library in their child's name. They raise funds to provide our libraries with author visits, guest speakers and additional computer programs/software. (Also work in the PFA Lounge periodically selling &amp; organizing books).</p>
	<p><b>SPORT BOOSTERS</b> support ASP's Middle School and Upper School athletic sports program. They raise funds through the sale of ASP logo wear and concessions. These funds have helped purchase our new bleachers in the new gymnasium. (Also work in the PFA Lounge organizing &amp; selling ASP Logo wear).</p>
	<p><b>SATURDAY SPORTS TEAM</b> coordinates the sports program for ASP's Lower and Middle School students. The objective of this program is to provide the children with a non-competitive atmosphere for participating in skill development, drills and fun, friendly games. The funds</p>

	collected cover the cost to run the program.
	<b>SENIOR PARENTS</b> help plan special activities and events every year to keep our hard-working seniors sane and to celebrate this, their special year! They do this by raising funds for the senior class events with champagne sales and an on-line silent auction. They coordinate graduation announcements, monthly treats, senior t-shirts, organize the Prom, award luncheon, graduation dinner, class gift and senior directory.
	<b>WELCOME COMMITTEE</b> organizes with Development, the Orientation Program including the Community Connections Fair and Living Skills seminar for the new families twice a year, August and February.
	<b>WELLNESS COMMITTEE</b> is a group of volunteer parents who work together with the school to bring new perspectives to the school in areas of environment, health, safety and well-being.
	<b>SCHOOL PORTRAITS</b> This small group coordinates the taking of student pictures with an outside photographer and the yearbook department. They schedule, collect funds and distribute pictures to the students.
	<b>COMMUNITY SERVICE</b> works with the Development Office putting together an overview of all the volunteer services provided by students and teachers in grades K-12, but the main task is coordinating the Community Room.
	<b>PFA LIAISONS</b> volunteer groups who work in direct liaison with the school divisions, home rooms and teachers. These representatives are often the first contact for new families arriving at ASP who wish to be more involved in their child's education and the school.
	<b>THANKSGIVING FAIR</b> - NOVEMBER 24 Help sell turkeys, sauce, pies and gifts for the Holiday.
	<b>HOLIDAY BOUTIQUE</b> - DECEMBER 5 A wonderful opportunity to buy seasonal gifts while the children make crafts in the Gingerbread House or visit Santa. This event allows the whole family to get into the spirit of the Holiday Season.
	<b>INTERNATIONAL DAY</b> - MAY 8 (TBC) Foods, games and more from around the world for the family to enjoy and celebrate our truly international community.
