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THE SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

The American School of Paris (ASP) is an independent, co-educational, English-language day school located in the Paris suburb of Saint-Cloud. The school is in session on a semester basis from mid-August through mid-June. Classes are held from 8:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The Upper School has an enrollment of approximately 390 students from more than 50 countries. ASP is accredited by the Council of International Schools and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, and is a member of the National Association for College Admission Counseling.

HONORS PROGRAM

The Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) courses constitute our honors program. We offer 15 AP courses and 24 IB courses.

Approximately one-third of our seniors are candidates for the IB Diploma each year, and over 90% participate in either the AP or IB program.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

An ASP diploma is awarded when a student earns a minimum of 24 credits and meets these requirements:

**Students are required to take French in grades 9 and 10. Grade 11 students must take at least one language course (French and/or Spanish). Grade 12 students are not required to take a foreign language if they have met the graduation requirements (three years of a foreign language).*
