ELECTIVE CLASSES

On the <u>ASP website</u>, under Middle School "Starting School" you will find lots of information on the school including supplies list, expectations and most importantly, right now, the "<u>6th Grade</u> <u>Elective Request Form</u>" or the "<u>7th and 8th Grade Elective Request Form</u>". We need this sheet to be completed and submitted as soon as possible. Completing this form gives you the best chance of getting into the elective classes you most want.

ORIENTATION

We have a great New Student Orientation Program on Monday, August 26th from 9:00 AM -12:30 PM to help you learn about the Middle School. At the orientation you will meet your teachers, as well as an "ambassador", someone in your child's grade that will help them the first few weeks of school. Your child will also tour the middle school!

EAL PLACEMENT TESTING:

Only for students receiving English Language Support

All EAL students will be assessed on their reading, writing, listening and speaking skills to guarantee the correct level of support that is offered throughout the year. This testing will take place from 1:00 to 3:30 PM on Monday, August 26th.

SUPPLIES AND SUMMER READING

ADVISORY

This is a small group of 12-15 students in your child's grade, who they will get to know very well. The Advisory teacher will be one of the core subject teachers and will meet with your child on August 26th during the Orientation Day.
