Join a week-long adventure in non-fiction storytelling and podcast creation. Hosted by News Decoder, a journalism education nonprofit, this workshop will teach students to identify and tell important stories through audio. Students will work with experienced journalists as they build media literacy, interviewing and global awareness skills.

At the end of the week, participants will come away with:

- Their very own podcast episode!
- The ability to formulate questions and interview people
- The skills to parse out reliable sources of information
- An understanding that problems they see around them are shared by people across the world
- The know-how to take information and turn it into an audio script
